Fifth graders are able to read comfortably for 30 minutes without getting tired or losing focus. Chapter books may be longer and more complex; the texts are more descriptive which is critical to plot development. Children are using clues from the story to understand unfamiliar settings and vocabulary. Talking about books during reading and reading books in a series can help make this easier. Nonfiction selections and magazines also help satisfy fifth graders' growing interest in the world around them. Reading several books about the same topic can help your child deepen his/her knowledge, while building confidence and expertise.
