Children are using clues from the story to understand unfamiliar settings and vocabulary. Talking about books during reading and reading books in a series can help make this easier. Nonfiction selections and magazines also help satisfy fifth graders' growing interest in the world around them. Reading several books about the same topic can help your child deepen his/her knowledge, while building confidence and expertise.
