Many third graders are interested in reading chapter books. Maintaining interest and understanding the storyline in these longer books can be challenging. Reading books in a series can help children with this; reading gets easier as your child gets to know characters and the author's style. While your child may be eager to read longer chapter books, consider reading picture books as well. Many picture books have challenging vocabulary and exciting story lines, and they help children grow as readers without the demands of a longer book. Continuing to read aloud (or listening to books) is also a great way to introduce your child to advanced vocabulary, new series, or new genres, and it can help reluctant readers develop an interest in books.
