Dear Family,

The staff members of the Mary Shoemaker School have compiled a suggested reading list for each grade level to assist families when selecting books for reading with their children. Many of these books can be found in our local library, at bookstores, or through some of our classroom orders such as Scholastic. Some of the titles on the list are great for children to read on their own, while others are perfect for reading aloud together. Reading is a lifelong journey and we hope the list provided will help in making selections for your children that they will enjoy. Happy reading!

Fourth graders are developing a stronger sense of authors, genres and topics that they like. Chapter books may be longer and more complex; keeping track of the story line or many characters can be a challenge. Talking about books during reading and reading books in a series can help make this easier. Sometimes *listening* to a book in a series first (either by reading it aloud or listening to a version of it on a device) can help your child “get into” a new series and make reading other books in the series a little easier. Nonfiction selections and magazines also help satisfy fourth graders’ growing interest in the world around them. Reading several books about the same topic can help your child deepen his/her knowledge, while building confidence and expertise.
