Dear Parents,

Our goal is to involve as many parents as possible throughout the school year in our class activities and events so not just a handful of parents are selected for classroom activities. If you are interested in volunteering for your child's classroom celebrations, please sign-up on the attached form from your child's teacher. **All classroom volunteers must be approved as a Tier I volunteer for the occasional classroom visitation or school event.** If you have siblings in the schools, please do not sign up for the same event in another homeroom. It is not possible to organize and participate for an activity from two locations. You may sign up for multiple events and are guaranteed participation in at least one event throughout the year pending BOE approval. The teacher will finalize the list of volunteers to ensure that parent representation is fair and adequate for each event. In addition, the teacher will be selecting one coordinating room parent from the list who will be responsible for organizing all classroom activities. This individual must also be available to attend each event. You can expect a list of assigned classroom volunteers to come home on September 28, 2018.

Field trip volunteers are separate from the classroom celebration volunteers and **require a Tier II approval process which requires a more comprehensive procedure. If you were approved as a Tier II volunteer in the past that approval will roll over as your child travels through our W-P school district and you will not be required to complete the fingerprinting portion again; however, you will still need to complete the Global Compliance Network Training (online training) and Volunteer Application if you are selected.** If you are interested in chaperoning a class field trip, please feel free to sign up. Unfortunately, not all parents will be able to attend the trip, as it is a random drawing by the homeroom teacher and a limited number of parents will be selected. One expectation of a chaperone is the supervision of children on the school bus; chaperones are expected to ride the school bus to and from the event.

Please be sure read the volunteer paperwork, letter from Mrs. Grossman, and the information from the teacher. If you should have any questions about this policy and our procedures, please be sure to ask.

There are many other opportunities to volunteer in our school: Spring Fair volunteer, Grandparents' Day, and much more! **Please keep in mind if you sign up for an activity during the school day siblings are not permitted to attend because during that time you will be assisting and supervising other children.** Thank you for taking the time to make our school year fun and exciting for the children.
