Language Arts Learning Activities for home

Read to your child every day!
Ask questions about story text (who and where questions)
Have fun with magnetic letters.
Practice writing and drawing on a whiteboard.
Have mealtime conversations.
Hunt for letters in the grocery store.
Color in a coloring book.
Attend a story time at your local library and check out new books while you're there.

Mathematics Learning Activities for home

Practice counting objects around the house (napkins at dinner, cans on the pantry shelf)
Write numbers in a tray covered with pudding
Sort household items and discuss the terms, more, less and equal
Play card games like Go Fish and Uno
Perform simple addition and subtraction (I have 3 carrots, if I eat one, how many will I have?)

Motor Skills Learning Activities for home

Play an imitation game like Follow the Leader
Play a Color and Shape Jumping game with paper shapes on the floor
Play outside or Play on playground equipment at the park
Use scissors to cut junk mail
Use tongs and tweezers to pick up cotton balls or other small items
Play in the sink with a turkey baster or eye droppers
Mold and form play doh

Social/Emotional Learning Activities for home

Host playdates with peers
Limit iPad and TV time
Model proper manners
Show your child how to dress independently
Let siblings and peers solve problems together
Focus on and reward correct behavior
Celebrate small victories!
