Academic Requirements

- ❖ A weighted 93 average is required for admission.
 - Honors and AP courses receive a 1.05 weighting.
- ❖ Averages will be recalculated for junior members at the end of 1st Semester. If the average falls below a 93, the member will receive a warning.
- ❖ Averages will be recalculated at the end of junior year. If the average for any member falls below a 93, the member will be dismissed .

Service Requirements

- ❖ Student applicants must provide proof on official letterhead of 20 or more volunteer hours donated to a certified non-profit organization. These 20 hours must be completed during the two years immediately preceding the year of NHS induction.
- ❖ Once inducted, members must perform 10 service hours per year:
 - 5 in service to the Woodstown-Pilesgrove School District or to a sending district.
 - 5 in service to the community, in or outside the school district.
- ❖ Members must participate in the peer-tutoring program.

Character Requirements

- ❖ Student applicants must demonstrate good character.
- ❖ Students with any suspensions or academic dishonesty are not eligible for NHS.
- ❖ Members who are suspended or receive discipline for academic dishonesty are immediately dismissed from NHS.
